

Slaughter Community Charter School Guidelines

Students who drive automobiles on campus will be responsible for all accidents, injury or damage caused by their driving or parking. SCCS is not responsible for any damage or loss of contents incurred to a vehicle on school grounds. Vehicles are parked and left at the owner's and driver's discretion.

Eligibility:

- Parking is a **privilege**, not a necessity, and may be revoked for failure to comply with school rules or parking guidelines.
- All students must have a current driver's license and remain eligible to drive.
- Student must have fewer than 4 unexcused absences and maintain a 2.5 GPA average.
- Students can have no suspensions for any reason.

Permits:

- Parking on the SCCS campus in designated student parking area is available for a fee of **\$15.00 cash** and parental/guardian permission as indicated on the application form. Lost, stolen, or misplaced parking tags may be replaced for \$15.00. Turn in a copy of drivers license and insurance with Parking Application.
- All automobiles parked on the school grounds must be registered with the school and parking pass must be displayed on the rear-view mirror when the vehicle is on campus.
- Automobiles without permits are subject to fines.
- You must notify the Office in writing if there are any changes to the type of vehicle you drive to school.

Arrival:

- Students should not arrive before 7:20 a.m. unless they have specific permission from the principal.
- Students are expected to exit their cars upon arrival and proceed directly into school. There will be no loitering in or around vehicles or leaving campus until the end of the school day unless otherwise authorized by the front office.

Expectations:

- Parking is strictly limited to the student parking area.
- All students must be licensed and covered by liability insurance (SCCS is not responsible for the automobile or its contents).
- No tobacco products on school property. Using tobacco products on school property is a violation. The driver (or passenger) will lose parking privileges for violating this rule in addition to school consequences.
- Irresponsible or reckless driving in the parking lots and around school property may result in suspension of parking privileges. This includes entering or exiting the parking area.
- Car stereo volume must be kept at a low level as not to attract attention to the car or disturb others.
- Students are not to go to their cars at any time during the school day without permission from an administrator.
- School administration reserves the right to suspend driving privileges for reasons other than the items listed above.

Parking Permit Application

Please Print. **ALL** information must be completed in full in order to receive a parking pass. Intentionally supplying incorrect information may result in the loss of parking privileges. A valid driver's license (not permit), current insurance card for the vehicle that will be driven to school, and **\$15 cash**, must be presented in order to receive a parking pass.
